Established in 1995\*, the Sewickley Shade Tree Commission is a group of volunteers who make recommendations regarding “.....the preservation, maintenance, planting, transplanting and removal of plants, shrubs and trees within the Borough.” In addition, **they approve the trimming or removal of Borough trees.**

Each year, the Shade Tree Commission hosts a booth at Sewickley’s May Mart where citizens can purchase a chance to win a tree.

1600 trees have been planted in public rights-of-way since 1995. We welcome volunteers to join us for our Spring planting on April 21 & 22, 2017.

The Commission holds membership with the Southwest PA Community Tree Association, the Arbor Day Foundation and the PA Urban and Community Forestry Council.
