MS4 NOTICE

The Borough of Sewickley Council is reviewing a revised MS4-Municipal Separate Storm System, Stormwater Management Program and Minimum Control Measure Plan. The Borough of Sewickley's primary goal of enacting and implementing this Stormwater Management Plan is to improve water quality in surface waters of the Commonwealth by reducing the contribution of pollutants from discharges from the Borough's Municipal Separate Storm System. Enactment of the Stormwater Management Plan will consist of implementing Best Management Practices aimed at improving water quality, as detailed in the plans for compliance with each Minimum Control Measure. The effectiveness of the Stormwater Management Plan is evaluated on an annual basis. As detailed as part of the written plan for each Minimum Control Measure, documentation of the results of each Best Management Practices are maintained throughout each permit year. Best Management Practices to address each Minimum Control Measure will be revised, improved or enhanced as needed based on the annual implementation results.

The Borough of Sewickley Council will discuss the Stormwater Management Plan at the August 9, 2016 Committee of the Whole Meeting, at 7:30 pm, and at the August 15, 2016 Council Meeting, at 7:30 pm. It is expected that the Borough of Sewickley Council will adopt the Stormwater Management Plan by Resolution at the August 15, 2016 Council Meeting.
