

**BOROUGH OF SEWICKLEY
REORGANIZATION MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 2, 2012**

Mayor Brian F. Jeffe opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jeffe administered the Oath of Office to Real Estate Tax Collector Maleet Gordon and Councilpersons William Cornman, Tom DeFazio, Robert Glenn and James Morrill.

Mayor Jeffe asked for nominations for Council President. On motion of Mrs. Aleshire, seconded by Mr. Cornman, the name of Robert Hague was placed in nomination for Council President. Mayor Jeffe closed nominations for President. The vote for Mr. Hague to become President of Council was 7-0.

Mayor Jeffe asked for nominations for Council Vice-President. On motion of Mr. DeFazio, seconded by Mr. Ference, the name of Susan Aleshire was placed in nomination for Council Vice-President. Mayor Jeffe closed nominations for Vice-President. The vote for Mrs. Aleshire to become Vice-President of Council was 7-0.

Mayor Jeffe asked for nominations for President Pro Tem. On motion of Mr. Ference, seconded by Mr. DeFazio, the name of William Cornman was placed in nomination for President Pro Tem. Mayor Jeffe closed nominations for President Pro Tem. The vote for Mr. Cornman to become President Pro Tem of Council was 7-0.

Mayor Jeffe passed the gavel to President Robert Hague who chaired the meeting.

On motion of Mr. Ference, seconded by Mr. DeFazio, Council voted, 7-0, to reappoint Kevin M. Flannery as Borough Secretary.

On motion of Mr. Ference, seconded by Mr. DeFazio, Council voted, 7-0, to reappoint Kevin M. Flannery as Borough Manager.

On motion of Mr. Ference, seconded by Mrs. Aleshire, Council voted, 7-0, to adopt Resolution No. 2012-001 reappointing Citizens Bank, Sewickley Office as Borough Depository and authorizing signers for the accounts.

On motion of Mr. Ference, seconded by Mrs. Aleshire, Council voted, 7-0, to appoint the Sewickley Herald and the Allegheny Times as official Borough newspapers for advertising purposes.

President Hague stated that he has directed the Borough Manager to place the Allegheny County Assessed Valuation topic on the Agenda for all future Council meetings.

President Hague thanked everyone for attending and invited everyone to enjoy the refreshments that have been provided.

On motion of Mr. Ference, seconded by Mr. Cornman, Council voted, 7-0, to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 7:42 p.m.
