

**BOROUGH OF SEWICKLEY
PARKING AUTHORITY MINUTES
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2016**

The Parking Authority Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairperson Tom DeFazio. In attendance were Cora DeLoia(arrived at 6:05 p.m.), Brian Jeffe, Fred Jezzi, and Dennis Yancheski. Also in attendance were Jennifer Markus and Alex Lancianese of Explore Sewickley, Stephanie Manos, Solicitor Fred Wolfe and Kevin M. Flannery.

On motion of Brian Jeffe, seconded by Fred Jezzi, the Parking Authority voted, 4-0, to approve the October 4, 2016 Meeting Minutes.

On motion of Dennis Yancheski, seconded by Brian Jeffe, the Parking Authority voted, 4-0, to approve the bills in the amount of \$5,080.07 reimbursable to the Borough of Sewickley, \$810.00 to Dave Von Kaenal for meter repair, \$31.50 for Total Trib Media for Ad, and \$286.00 for Tucker Arensberg legal work.

The Authority reviewed the pay stations delivery date. Four machines are scheduled to arrive mid-November for installation with the remaining 38 machines to arrive in December. PSX was also going to begin the installation of the concrete bases in the business district.

The Authority discussed a logo from one of the three presented by Explore Sewickley. Fred Jezzi suggested that the Authority should meet with a professional design group for the logo. Others asked if the parking logo tear drop concept could have the color green instead of red. On motion of Dennis Yancheski, seconded by Brian Jeffe, the Parking Authority voted, 4-1 with Mr. Jezzi voting no, to have the logo presented with a green color.

The Authority continued discussion with the Meter Feeder mobile application. Sewickley Police Department to continue working with Meter Feeder to confirm that it is synced with the Borough's Visual Alert program.

The Authority then addressed the potential parking garage. Brian Jeffe suggested that the Authority meet with a design architect to proceed with the project. Several members stated that discussion should be on staying at the legal height limit but also looking at one floor above the height requirement to say four stories. On motion of Dennis Yancheski, seconded by Brian Jeffe, the Parking Authority voted, 5-0, to set up a meeting to walk the Green Street area with WTW Architects for 10 am on Friday, November 18, 2016.
